Salmon Creek Bridge, West Uncas Road MP 0.804

This project is for the construction of a bridge on West Uncas Road at milepost 0.804 over Salmon Creek. The project will be constructed during the summer/fall of 2018. The bridge will replace the existing culvert, which forms a barrier to fish passage, including Summer Chum Salmon. With construction of the new bridge, 0.75 miles of prime spawning habitat in Salmon Creek will be made accessible. The work includes removal of the existing culvert, reconstruction of the stream bed, installation of a pile foundation, concrete abutments and concrete girders, a structural earth wall, bridge rail, guardrail, and new pavement. The project will require closure of West Uncas Road at the project site for a period of up to 6 months, beginning in mid-June 2018.

This project is funded at 85% by the WA State Recreation & Conservation Office (RCO) Salmon Recovery Funding Board, with the remaining 15% funded by a U.S. Fish & Wildlife National Fish Passage Program, and the County Road Fund.

Construction of the project has been awarded to Nordland Construction NW Inc., of Nordland WA, for their bid of \$942,367.
