OlyCAP's Homeless Shelter and Housing Programs: 2009

HAINES STREET COTTAGES FAMILY SHELTER: Year-round emergency shelter for homeless families with children; victims of domestic violence are prioritized for service. Between 30 and 32 beds are available. Families may stay up to 90 days and are provided with comprehensive case management and ancillary services.

FAMILY TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM: Up to eight, 2-bedroom apartments are available in Port Townsend for homeless families with children. Families may stay up to 2 years and receive case management and direct referral for needed services. The goal for these families is long-term permanent housing.

CROSSROADS TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM: This 2-year housing program is designed for homeless single adults coming directly out of in-patient facilities for alcohol/drug treatment. Participants live in congregate housing and receive specialized case management and aftercare services to support their sobriety. Eleven beds are available.

HOLCOMB HOUSE: This home provides congregate living (permanent supportive housing in individual private rooms with shared community spaces) for four disabled low-income single adults referred by Jefferson Mental Health, or for individuals who are disabled and referred by another community service agency.

HASTINGS HOUSE: This home provides congregate living (permanent supportive housing in individual private rooms with shared community spaces) for five-to-six disabled low-income single adults referred by Jefferson Mental Health, or for individuals who are disabled and referred by another community service agency.

PFEIFFER HOUSE: This building offers six, 1-bedroom apartments of permanent supportive housing for low-income single adults referred by Jefferson Mental Health, or for individuals who are disabled and referred by another community service agency.

NORTHWEST PASSAGE PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING: Up to six, 1-bedroom apartments for single adults referred by Jefferson Mental Health, or who are otherwise disabled and referred by another community service agency.

SOUTH SEVEN SENIOR VILLAGE: Permanent, low-income apartments for people over the age of 62; these fifteen units are located in Port Hadlock. Property management and supportive services are provided by OlyCAP.

REACH PROGRAM: (*Rental Education, Accessing Community Housing*) This program aims to place 45 homeless families, or approximately 135 individuals, into permanent housing over a three-year period, through a "housing first" model that combines a housing locator service, tenant education component and ongoing support for families and property owners. Victims of domestic violence, heads of households who are US military veterans, and families with a disabled or elderly member are prioritized for services. (**Note: this program is for families with children only, and not for single adults.**)

JEFFERSON COUNTY WINTER SHELTER: In partnership with COAST (*Community Outreach Association Shelter Team*), the American Legion Post #26 and OlyCAP: Seasonal winter night shelter for single adults (over age 18) in Jefferson County runs approximately 90 or more nights and operates daily from 4 p.m. until 8 a.m., usually late November to early March. Services include three meals daily and referral to community resources. Approximately 18 beds are available each night. Winter Shelter is mostly for Jefferson County men, but will accept two-to-three women per night in cases of extreme emergency.

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
