

SED Criteria

1. Natural:
 - a. Significant natural feature such as steep slope, delta, or feeder bluff ,or,
 - b. Almost completely un-built, and,
 - c. Not close to a road, and,
 - d. Of viable size
2. Conservancy
 - a. Mostly un-built, and,
 - b. Not close to a road
3. Residential
 - a. At least ½ built out
4. High Intensity
 - a. Mostly built out, or,
 - b. ½ built out, and,
 - c. industry or commerce present

EE	The quarry at Mats Mats should be conservancy rather than natural. The Coastal atlas shows the breakwater is 71-100 percent modified shoreline. The quarry shoreline has too much boat traffic and is too impacted by heavy equipment operations to be natural.
