

SED Criteria

1. Natural:
 - a. Significant natural feature such as steep slope, delta, or feeder bluff ,or,
 - b. Almost completely un-built, and,
 - c. Not close to a road, and,
 - d. Of viable size

2. Conservancy
 - a. Mostly un-built, and,
 - b. Not close to a road

3. Residential
 - a. At least ½ built out

4. High Intensity
 - a. Mostly built out, or,
 - b. ½ built out, and,
 - c. industry or commerce present

Reach Comments

II This is the boat channel between the peninsula and Indian Island. The Coastal Atlas shows the peninsula side having 71-100 percent shoreline modification. The delta at the south end should probably be conservancy, but the shoreline itself should be residential. Another factor is the heavy boat traffic through the channel.
