See Article 8.2. Aquaculture – Regulations in items “B” and “C”

Consider inserting the following language into each of the aquatic environmental designations:

OR as the first regulation in 8.2.C (to replace the existing one)

Net Pen aquaculture shall be prohibited until such time as processes and techniques have been developed that are shown to prevent: a) the release of any harmful materials (such as herbicides, pesticides, antibiotics, fertilizers, parasites (sea lice) or genetically modified organisms) and b) the escape of the fish being raised into the surrounding water.

Consider inserting the following language into each of the terrestrial environmental designations:

Or as the second regulation in 8.2.C

Net Pen aquaculture employing processes and techniques that will prevent the release of harmful materials into an aquatic or onto a terrestrial site may be allowed subject to a conditional use permit.
