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Article 6.6 Shoreline Setbacks and Heights – Regulations in 6.6.B (pg 6-18)

Consider adding a regulation addressing the issue of a sea-level increase as a likely impact of Climate Change.

Add a regulation 6.6.B.5

As a measure to address the potential of a rise in sea-level; those developments on no-bank or low-bank marine shorelines shall have the bottom of their foundations be at least three (3) feet higher than the level of the ordinary high water mark.

OR

Add a Policy 6.6.A.2

As a measure to address the potential of a rise in sea-level; the *proponent is* county encourages those developments on no-bank or low-bank marine shorelines consider the bottom of their foundations be at least three (3) feet higher than the level of the ordinary high water mark.
