Canopy: collective branches and foliage of a tree or group of trees' crowns. Aggregate or collective tree crowns. A canopy can be closed or partially closed as in a forest or woodland stand, or composed of both individual trees and closed canopy groups as in an urban forest canopy.

Canopy cover: For an individual tree is the drip line area. For a buffer area comprising multiple trees it is the sum of the drip line areas of each tree less any overlap.

Drip line area: means the area measured from the trunk of the tree outward to a point at the perimeter of the outermost branch structure of the tree.
