Shoreline Planning Update:

Anyone who owns waterfront property or enjoys our local lakes, streams, rivers and marine shorelines may be interested to know that Jefferson County is currently working to update its 1989 Shoreline Master Program (SMP) as mandated by the State's 2003 SMP Guidelines. The public benefits from the SMP's management of both salt- and freshwater shoreline resources to encourage water-dependent uses, promote public access and protect ecological functions.

Public input and participation are key to the update process and are being accomplished through two advisory committees, open public meetings, two Shoreline Charrette events, and formal review processes with public comment periods.
