**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
JEFFERSON COUNTY
SHORELINE TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The Jefferson County Shoreline Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) will meet on **Tuesday, November 6, 2007, and Tuesday November 27 at 8:00 a.m.**, at the Jefferson County Library, 620 Cedar Ave, Port Hadlock. The meeting is open to the public, but is not a public hearing.

The committee consists of scientific and natural resource experts from the community representing various specialties including representatives of local governmental entities, state agencies and tribal co-managers. The STAC's ongoing agenda is to review and provide input on technical inventory evaluations and restoration analyses to support the project's policy committee and to assist County staff and consultants with a comprehensive update of the Jefferson County Shoreline Master Program (SMP). The SMP update is mandated by Washington State's Shoreline Management Act (RCW 90.58) and the 2003 SMP Guidelines (Chapter 173-26 WAC). Due to a project extension, Planning Commission public review and recommendation, Board of County Commissioners review, and subsequent submittal to Washington Department of Ecology are expected to be complete by June 12, 2009.
