SHORELINE POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Jefferson County Shoreline Policy Advisory Committee (SPAC) will meet on **Tuesday, September 18, 2007, at 12:30 p.m.**, at the WSU Learning Center Spruce Room, Shold Business Park, 201 West Patison, Port Hadlock. The meeting is open to the public, but is not a public hearing. Additional SPAC meetings will be held at 12:30 pm on the following Tuesdays at various locations:

- September 25 at WSU Learning Center Spruce Room;
- October 9 at Tri Area Community Center in Chimacum;
- October 16 at Port Ludlow Beach Club in Port Ludlow;
- October 23 at Tri Area Community Center;
- November 6 at WSU Learning Center Spruce Room;
- November 13 at WSU Learning Center Spruce Room;
- November 27 at Tri Area Community Center;
- December 4 at WSU Learning Center Spruce Room; and
- December 11 at WSU Learning Center Spruce Room

The committee consists of citizen stakeholders from the community representing various interest sectors along with representatives of local governmental entities, state agencies and tribal co-managers. The SPAC's ongoing agenda is to review and provide input on the draft proposed goals, policies, environment designations and regulations to assist County staff and consultants with a comprehensive update of the Jefferson County Shoreline Master Program (SMP). The SMP update is mandated by Washington State's Shoreline Management Act (RCW 90.58) and the 2003 SMP Guidelines (Chapter 173-26 WAC). Due to a project extension, Planning Commission public review and recommendation, Board of County Commissioners review, and subsequent submittal to Washington Department of Ecology are expected to be complete by June 12, 2009.
