Dear Sir/Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the PUD's proposed Service Area boundary changes, as required by the Jefferson County Coordinated Water System Plan (CWSP), 30 June 1997.

In order to better plan at a regional level the PUD has proposed changing its Quimper Water System service area boundaries. In accordance with Section 4, Boundary Adjustments, to Exhibit 3-2, Agreement for Establishing Water Utility Service Area Boundaries, of the CWSP:


"such modification must receive written concurrence (which shall not be unreasonably withheld) of all utilities that would be directly affected by such a boundary adjustment and the legislative authority(ies) having jurisdiction."

Enclosed is a copy of our proposed changes. We are not proposing any changes on the north side of the existing service area and therefore should not be affecting any of those purveyors: Kala Point Utility Company, Port Townsend, nor the Cape George Colony. We will also not affect the Olympic Mobile Village Water System.

Along Oak Bay, we are proposing to expand the service area south to our Mats Mats Bay Water System. We have received petitions in the past for water systems along Discovery Bay and need to plan for the eventual expansion to service the area. This should not affect any of the existing service areas as reflected in the CWSP. This will place us close to the Port Ludlow and Olympus Beach Tracts Water Systems, but will not affect their service areas.

Along Discovery Bay we will be extending the service area to around Anderson Lake Road. Again we have been petitioned for water in that area. To properly plan to meet future demands we need to adjust our service area accordingly. This will not affect any existing service areas. The closest system would be Moe-Tel Water System at end of Discovery Bay.

Although we are not going to cause any changes to other utility service areas we would appreciate your questions or comments, please call. After reviewing the proposed service area changes please provide your written support by signing this letter and returning it to the PUD. We will include it, and any comments when we forward our request to the WUCC, County and DOH.

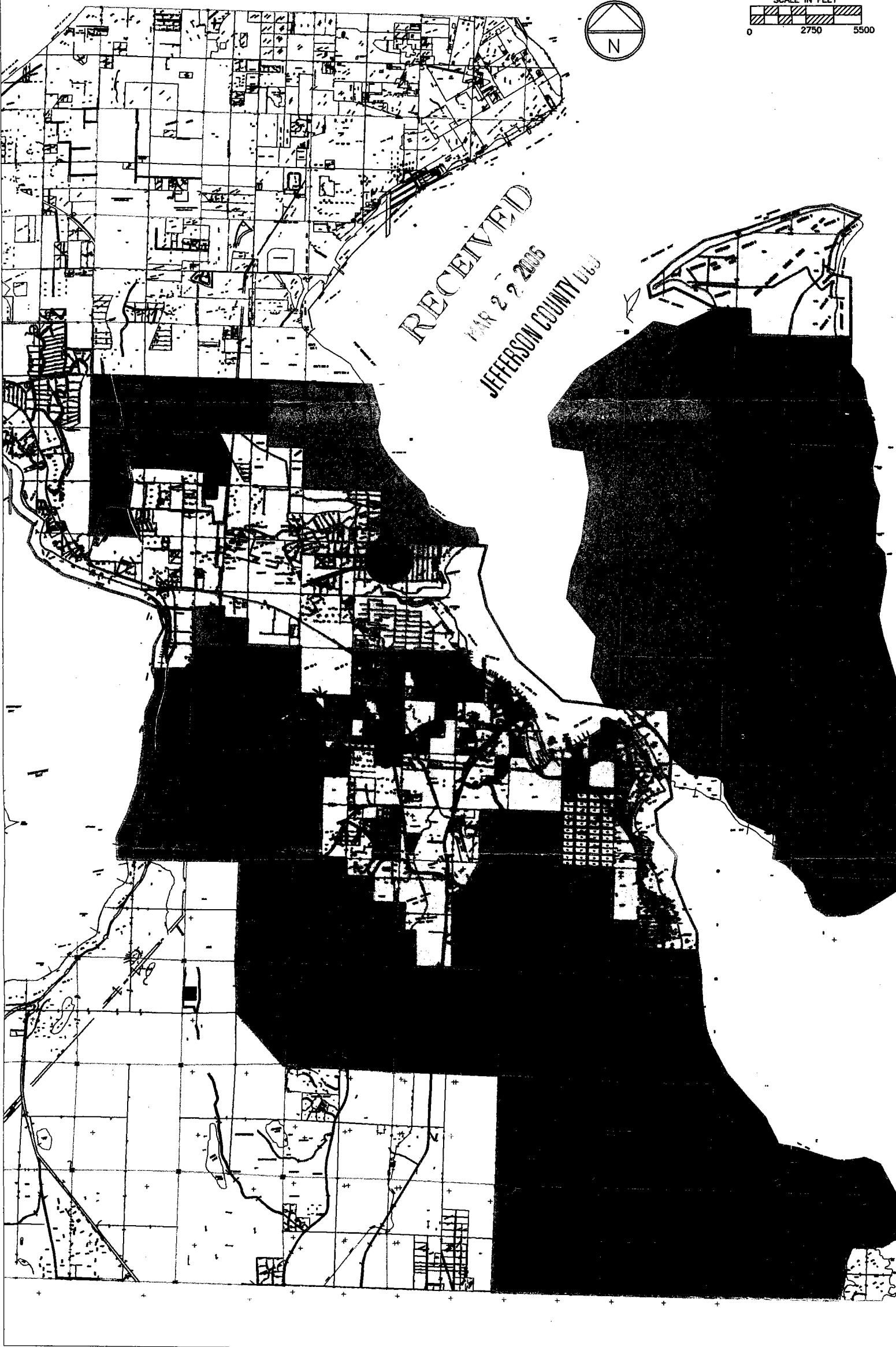
