Subject: Hold a public hearing for amending the 2011-2016 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (6-yr TIP)

Statement of Issue:

Hold a public hearing at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, February 28 for the purpose of receiving public testimony concerning amendment of the 2011-2016 Jefferson County Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (6-yr TIP). Attached is the proposed adoption resolution.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pros & Cons:

The Board adopted the 2011-2016 6-yr TIP on October 18, 2010 through Resolution 45-10. To enable the acquisition of \$925,000 of federal funds awarded to Jefferson County through the County Road Safety Program 2010, a Run-Off-Road & Intersection Safety Project needs to be added to the current TIP. Adding a project to the TIP requires a hearing, which has been duly noticed.

Fiscal Impact/Cost-Benefit Analysis:


Amending the TIP at this time will put the County in a position to receive federal county road safety funds to make safety improvements on County major and minor collectors between now and end of 2013.
