

Subject: Call for Bids, Willoughby Creek Bridge Emergency Repair, Upper Hoh Rd. M.P. 3.50, Federal Aid Project No. ER-0902(318), County Project No. XO1825

Statement of Issue: The Board is asked to approve the Call for Bids for the Willoughby Creek Bridge Emergency Repair, County Project No. XO1825.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: High flows in Willoughby Creek, beginning on January 6, 2009 scoured the west bridge approach, causing damage to the riprap abutment protection and threatening the approach roadway. Existing bank armoring upstream of the bridge was also damaged. Public Works has completed the plans and specifications for a permanent repair to stabilize the approach roadway and reconstruct the damaged bank armoring. This Call for Bids is for construction of the permanent repair.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The engineer's estimate is \$554,488. This will be funded at 86.5% by the Federal Highway Administration, and 13.5% by the County Road Fund.


Recommendation: The Board is requested to sign the Call for Bids, and return to Public Works.

CALL FOR BIDS

**Willoughby Creek Bridge Repair
County Project No. XO1825**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, State of Washington, will receive sealed bids up until the hour of **9:30 a.m. on Monday, April 25, 2011** at the Office of the County Commissioners, basement level of the Jefferson County Courthouse, 1820 Jefferson Street, P.O. Box 1220, Port Townsend, Washington, 98368, for construction of the Willoughby Creek Bridge Repair, County Project No. XO1825. Sealed bids will be opened and read publicly at **10:15 a.m., or shortly thereafter**, on the same day in the Jefferson County Commissioners Chambers, basement level of the Jefferson County Courthouse.

This contract provides for repair of Willoughby Creek Bridge (Bridge No. 08339400) at Upper Hoh Road milepost 3.50. Work includes installation of a sheet pile retaining wall, repair of riprap abutment protection and stream bank protection, installation of engineered log jams, and other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications. This contract is subject to construction timing restrictions.

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with the plans and specifications on file at the Department of Public Works, 623 Sheridan Street, Port Townsend, Washington, where copies may be obtained by prospective bidders. Hard copies and/or electronic copies may also be obtained by calling the Department of Public Works at (360) 385-9160.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a surety bond, postal money order, cash, cashiers check or certified check payable to the Treasurer of Jefferson County in the sum of five (5%) percent of the bid amount, to be forfeited to Jefferson County by the successful bidder if he/she fails to enter into a contract and file an acceptable surety bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price within ten (10) days of the award. The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to accept the bid deemed most advantageous to Jefferson County, and to waive all informalities in the bidding.

Jefferson County, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.
