Statement of Issue:

The Board is asked to approve the 'Call for Bids' for the above referenced County Road Project No. CR-1806.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's:

Execution of the Call for Bids will allow for the advertisement of this project for construction. This project will consist of roadway reconstruction including improvements to width, alignment, surfacing, and drainage, and will include construction of pedestrian facilities.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis:

The Engineer's Estimate is \$212,643.14. This project is listed as priority item 5 on the 2011-2016 Six Year Transportation Improvement Program, and as item 4 on the 2011 Annual Construction Program. This improvement project will be funded with local roads funds.


Recommendation:

East Price Street Improvement Project; County Project No. 1805951806 (CR-1806)
County Rd. No. 667009, M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.25, in Irondale, Jefferson County, WA.

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, State of Washington, will receive sealed bids up until the hour of **9:30 a.m. on Monday, May 2, 2011** at the Office of the County Commissioners, basement level of the Jefferson County Courthouse, 1820 Jefferson Street, P.O. Box 1220, Port Townsend, Washington, 98368, for construction of the East Price Street Improvement Project; County Project No. 1805951806 (CR-1806). Sealed bids will be opened and read publicly at 10:00 a.m., or shortly thereafter, on the same day in the Jefferson County Commissioners Chambers, basement level of the Jefferson County Courthouse.

This Contract provides for roadway reconstruction including widening and realignment, clearing and grubbing, roadway excavation, construction of roadway drainage structures, placement and grading of crushed surfacing, and other work on East Price Street in preparation for surfacing with bituminous surface treatment (BST-chipseal) by others, all in accordance with the Contract Plans, Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications.

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with the plans and specifications on file at the office of the Director of Public Works, 623 Sheridan Street, Port Townsend, Washington, where copies may be obtained by prospective bidders. Copies may also be obtained by calling the Department of Public Works at (360) 385-9160.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a surety bond, postal money order, cash, cashiers check or certified check payable to the Treasurer of Jefferson County in the sum of five (5%) percent of the bid amount, to be forfeited to Jefferson County by the successful bidder if he/she fails to enter into a contract and file an acceptable surety bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price within twenty (20) days of the award. The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to accept the bid deemed most advantageous to Jefferson County, and to waive all informalities in the bidding.

Jefferson County, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.
