

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING:
HOH TRIBE WATER SYSTEM FRANCHISE**

Notice is hereby given that the Jefferson County Board of Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on Monday July 25, 2011 at 10:30 AM in the Commissioners' Chambers at the Jefferson County Courthouse, 1820 Jefferson Street, Port Townsend, Washington, to take testimony concerning a proposed Resolution granting a nonexclusive franchise to the Hoh Tribe to construct, maintain, and operate a water system within County Road rights-of-way located in Sections 20, 21, 27 & 28 Township 26 North, Range 13 West. This line will convey water from a well on property owned by the Hoh Tribe to members within the Reservation and other public service facilities.
