Proposed Tax Increase for 2012: (Pursuant to Chapter 84.55.120 RCW)

The Board of County Commissioners has proposed increases of up to one percent (1%) in the County Regular Tax Levy and the County Road District Tax Levy and for the County Conservation Futures Tax Levy plus increases for all levies resulting from new construction, improvement to property, any increase in the assessed value of state-assessed property, and any refunds from the previous year.
