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**Statement of Issue:** A Resolution adding the SR 19 Pedestrian Crossing Improvement, Trail Connection, and Student Encouragement project to the 2012 Annual Construction Program.


**Analysis / Strategic Goals / Pros & Cons:** Jefferson County has been awarded Safe Routes to School grant funds to improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities on SR 19 and West Valley Road, and to encourage students to walk and bike to the Chimacum School through education and traffic enforcement activities.

**Fiscal Impact /Cost-Benefit Analysis:** The estimated project cost is \$464,900. The Safe Routes to School grant is for \$438,700 to cover engineering, construction, and the education and enforcement activities. \$26,200 from the Road Fund is estimated for right-of-way acquisition along SR 19.

**Recommendation:** Sign the attached Resolution adding the project to the 2012 Annual Road Construction Program, which authorizes Public Works to begin work on the project.
