Subject: Bid Award for 2013 Supply of Liquid Asphalt Products

Statement of Issue:

Public Works staff has completed checking the bids opened on January 7, 2013 for the 2013 Supply of Liquid Asphalt Products, and finds it to be in the County's best interest to award a Purchase & Sale Agreement to Albina Asphalt of Vancouver, WA for the amounts specified in their bid.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's:

Bid Award is consistent with the County's goals in that it provides for maintenance of the County roads infrastructure. This product is used in the County's pavement surfacing and preservation program.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis:

Purchase of these materials is accounted for in the 2013 Road Operations Budget. Estimated Purchase & Sale Agreement amount is \$418,000.00 plus Washington State Sales Tax; however, there is no guaranteed minimum order with the supplier. (This is a supply Agreement).

Recommendation:



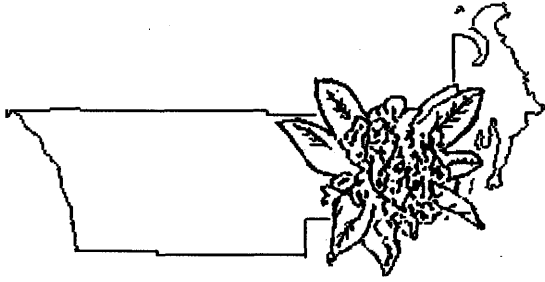


