

**Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis:** The Bid amount of \$1,856,000 will be funded at 100% by the Federal Highway Administration.

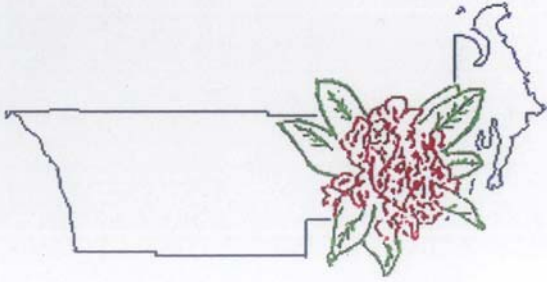
**Recommendation:** Public Works recommends that the Board authorize the Award of Contract to Western Industrial, Inc., and return the original to Public Works for further processing.
