Subject: Center Road Asphalt Overlay Phase 6 (MP 4.39 - MP 6.86)
Resolution to Improve Roadway

Statement of Issue: Adopt the attached Resolution which creates a project to resurface and restore (2R) Center Road from milepost 4.39 to 6.86 and adds the project to the 2013 Annual Road Construction Program.

Analysis/Strategic Goals/Pro's & Con's: The Center Road Asphalt Overlay Phase 6 project will rehabilitate the paved surface of this roadway segment by constructing a 2-inch asphalt overlay. The project begins at milepost MP 4.39 where the Phase 4 asphalt overlay was constructed in 2009 with Federal stimulus funds and ends at milepost MP 6.68 at the SR-104 overpass. This is project #18 on the 2013-2018 Six Year Transportation Improvement Plan. Construction is scheduled for summer 2014.

Fiscal Impact/Cost Benefit Analysis: The project is estimated to cost \$1,015,000. Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds will cover 86.5% of the project cost with remaining funds coming from the local Public Infrastructure Fund (PIF).

Recommendation: Please adopt and sign the attached Resolution adding the project to the 2013 Annual Road Construction Program.
