

NEW TARBOO CREEK CULVERTS AT DABOB ROAD AND CENTER ROAD

In 2003 Jefferson County Public Works and the Hood Canal Salmon Enhancement Group (HCSEG) partnered on the replacement of two fish passage barrier culverts on Tarboo Creek at Dabob Rd and Center Rd.

HCSEG acquired State Salmon Recovery grants to pay for 80% of the \$650,000 project and Jefferson County contributed the remaining 20%. HCSEG managed the design and construction of these projects with assistance from Public Works.

Salmon and other fish can now pass freely from the mouth of the creek to its source near State Route 104 at the Olympic Music Festival property. Jefferson County has over 80 fish passage barriers on its road system that require correction. Thanks to this partnership with HCSEG and the State Salmon Recovery funding grants, two of those barriers can now be removed from the list.
