- waxed cardboard

For all: flatten
Curbside service: bundle & tie

Plastic & Cans

Glass



glass bottles & jars
no blue glass; no lids; labels OK



buckets
limit of 3



metal cans
NO lids



clean aluminum cans, pans & foil

Recycle plastic by type not number.



plant pots
rigid plastic only; 12" max



bottles, jugs & jars

Place **clean and empty** recyclables **loose** in bins.

Don't place bagged or boxed recyclables in bins.
