THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 200__, by and between Jefferson County Department of Public Works, Washington, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and _____ hereinafter referred to as "Volunteer Group". The Volunteer Group agrees to adopt _____, County Road No. _____ between M.P. _____ & M.P. _____. The duration of this Agreement shall commence on the date first written above and terminate upon written notification by either party.

WITNESSETH: It is Hereby Covenanted and Agreed to as Follows:

1. Each Volunteer Group will have a designated group coordinator or designee who will be responsible for coordinating at least (3) three days in advance of each litter clean up event with the County. This will include picking up and returning safety equipment used during the clean up event, completing and returning the Volunteer Registration Form and disposing of litter at the Jefferson County Transfer Station.
2. The County shall provide safety equipment to be used during the litter clean up event, garbage bags, and authorization to dispose of trash at no cost at the Jefferson County Transfer Station located off of Jacob Miller Rd. The County will install a street sign acknowledging the Volunteer Group along the portion of road being adopted.
3. The Volunteer Group agrees that by participating in the Department of Public Works Volunteer Litter Control Program, they will not represent themselves as employees of the Department. It is understood that volunteers are responsible for their actions and will exercise due care in performing volunteer services for the Department. It's also understood that volunteers are entitled to receive coverage during volunteer hours for medical treatment necessitated by a service related injury or illness under the Medical Aid Provisions of the Workers Compensation Act, which is administered by the Department of Labor and Industries, but not for loss of time due to injury or illness, nor for lasting disability or death.
4. It is understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the County will require Volunteer Groups to remain active and may be available upon request from the County to perform litter clean up event should it become necessary. If the Volunteer Group is deemed inactive action will be taken to have the portion of road re-adopted by an active group.
