

Reimbursements available for permit-exempt well metering devices in Quilcene-Snow (WRIA 17) Watershed

Save up to \$250.00!

Effective December 31, 2009, all *new* water uses in the Quilcene-Snow watershed must be measured.

For a limited time, the state Department of Ecology has money available to reimburse individual owners of new permit-exempt wells (under RCW 90.44.050) for the cost of a metering device. Individual owners seeking reimbursement must submit an application request and sign a formal contract with Ecology.

When the meter has been purchased and installed, and a certificate of installation signed and submitted, the owner will be reimbursed.
