## Hoh River Resiliency Plan PHASE I

Directions to Hoh Valley Cabins at Elk Meadows: From Forks, travel south on Hwy 101 for 13.1 miles. Turn Left on the Upper Hoh Road. Travel 5.8 miles. Turn Left just after the Hard Rain Café and park above Nikolai Memorial. Please note, the aerial image isn't up to date.



Directions to Fletcher Ranch: From Cabin, follow Upper Hoh Road west to Hwy 101. Turn Left and go 2.6 miles to the Hoh Mainline. Turn Left. Travel 4.5 miles to Maple Creek Rd. Go Left for 2.3 miles to Owl Creek Rd. and turn Left again. Go 1.6 miles and park on the right near the shop or house.
